DROP-IN ACTIVITIES

11.30–3pm: Workshop 305 Communal Clay Sculpture (all ages) Mould clay into figures/animals as part of this community sculpture.

2–4pm: Tim Norris sculpture workshop using gathered natural materials. All children and adults welcome

11am–1pm, 2pm–4pm: Clay leaf bowls with Hags Pottery (5+ years) Make your own clay bowl with a leaf imprint. There is an option to pay to glaze and fire the bowl.

Art Hub (children 3+ years) The Art hub will be a drop-in activity zone with a variety of projects to come and paint, stick, draw and sculpt. Aimed at children 3 years and up.

Giant group drawing (all ages) Gather some sticks or leaves and turn them into your own drawing tools!

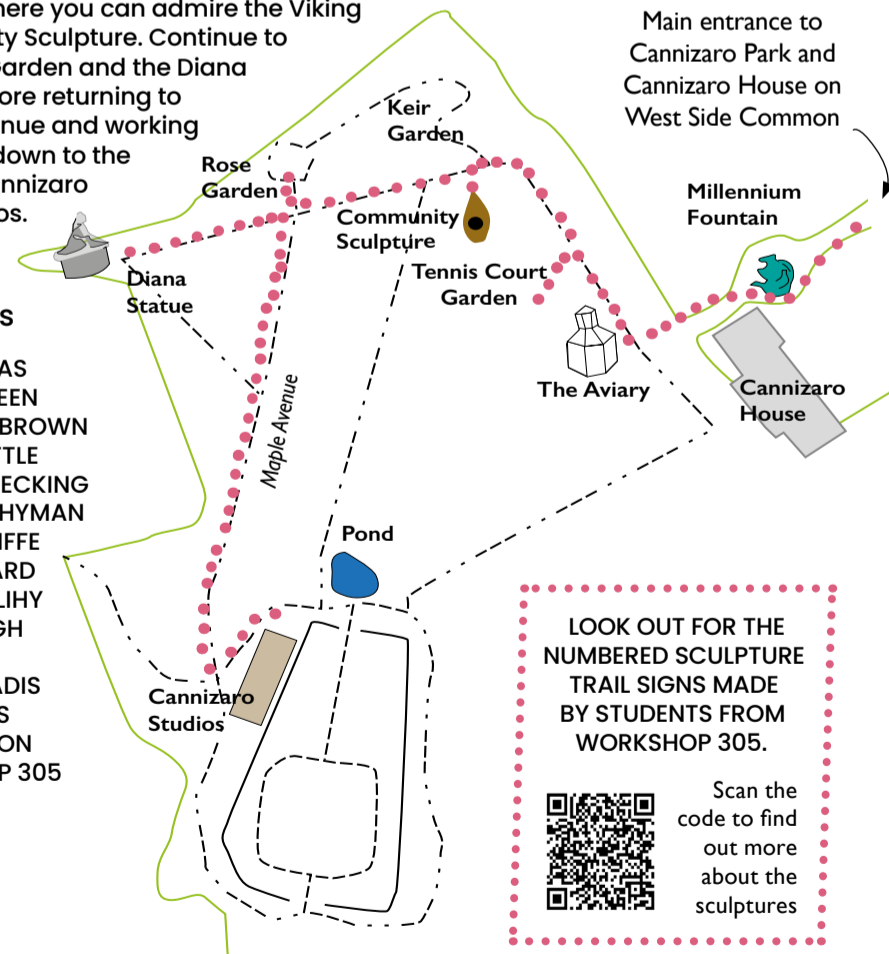
VIKING SCULPTURE TRAIL

The Sculpture Trail starts at the teapot fountain inside the park. Next, head to the Aviary and turn right down the path to the Tennis Court Garden where you can admire the Viking Community Sculpture. Continue to the Rose Garden and the Diana Statue before returning to Maple Avenue and working your way down to the ACAVA Cannizaro Park Studios.
